## PART II. DESCRIPTION OF ACTIONS

Adhrit Foundation has undertaken wide range of activities which promote the Ten Principles of United Nations Global Compact. Few of them are as follows:

1. Organised the **Indian Law Conclave**, a two day National Legal Conclave. The conclave brought together academicians, lawyers, legislators, bureaucrats and students in order to encourage discussion over legal issues and promote multidisciplinary approach to the policy making process. It had delegates from all over India who will engage in two days of rigorous learning, reflection and sharing of knowledge, skills, experiences and perspectives. The conclave provided attractive awards, prizes and networking opportunities to the delegates. The second edition of conclave was held on 10th and 11th August, 2019 at the International Youth Hostel, New Delhi and the third edition of the conclave was held on 31st October and 1st November, 2020 in Virtual Mode.
2. Supported various initiatives of the Alexis Group - **World Law Conclave 2021, Samvaad 2020, SDG Action Conclave 2020, Social Impact Dialogue 2020, Climate Change Conclave 2020, Indian Economy Symposium 2019** and **Indian Leadership Conclave 2019**.
3. Implemented the **Action Plan 2020** to align our new initiatives and activities towards general principles of sustainability and transparency along with Ten Principles of UN Global Compact.

4. Started **Vidhi**, a project for legal empowerment of citizens and training of law students. Through the Vidhi.org portal, we provided online internships to over 1000+ law students during Covid-19 crisis. We also organised 50+ free webinars on the legal topics of contemporary relevance.

5. Published a book - **Indian Law Conclave Review - Volume 1** on 10th August, 2020. RRRNA under the aegis of Ministry of Education, Government of India has allotted the ISBN - 978-81-935257-1-5 to this book.

6. Published a book - **Latest Trends in Cyber Law & Cyber Crimes** on 31st March, 2021. RRRNA under the aegis of Ministry of Education, Government of India has allotted the ISBN - 978-81-951489-2-9 to this book.

## PART III. MEASUREMENT OF OUTCOMES

Our initiatives and activities have yielded both quantitative and qualitative outcomes.

1. We have engaged 200+ delegates through the 2019 and 2020 editions of the Indian Law Conclave. After the events, the delegates become our alumni/ambassadors and actively promote our commitment towards Ten Principles of UN Global Compact in their workplaces, universities, and cities.

2. We have trained 10000+ students through our Webinars. These students research, create online and offline campaigns, and write blogs on topics related to Ten Principles of UN Global Compact. This creates lot of awareness about the pertinent issues through both online and offline engagement with various stakeholders.

3. We have engaged with 50,000+ people through social media and email newsletters to raise awareness about Ten Principles of UN Global Compact amongst various stakeholders. Furthermore, our website has 100,000+ unique visitors during this period.

In the near future, we look forward to engage with more stakeholders, our focus will be to engage with Business Participants and Educational Institutions for research, awareness, sharing of best practices, and commentary on COE activities.
